**Dates:** If you are signing up for more than one ranch clinic please make out a separate check for each clinic and be sure to put the date of the clinic in the "for" section on each check.

**Time:** Friday afternoon (any time after 1:00 and before 7:00) – everyone arrives and gets themselves and their horses settled. Saturday-Monday mornings we gather at 8:00 and get instructions for the day from the “cow boss” for each day’s events.

**Meals:** Breakfast is on your own before you head out to the ranch each day. We “gather up” for lunch at the ranch or on trail ride days, we may need to “pack” in our lunch. Be prepared with canteen bags or saddle bags to take a lunch with you on the trail, just in case. You will need to bring your lunch each day regardless and we will have lots of coolers & 2 very small refrigerators to put them in during the day. Then for supper we all agree on a restaurant and go out for evening meals, Dutch treat. We have some really awesome choices of eateries in Cheyenne, Wellington and Fort Collins area, all within 30 minutes of the ranch!

**Stalls/Pens:** There are a limited number of individual stalls available. Please indicate here with a number whether your horse will need a stall \_\_\_\_\_ or if your horse can go in a pen with another horse (if you are trailering in with a friend maybe your horses can go in a pen together) \_\_\_\_\_. All stalls and pens are reserved on a “first deposit received” basis.

Stalls are \$15.00 per night and pens are \$10.00 per night. You will need to bring your own hay/feed, feed buckets, and shavings for stalls. You will need to bring your own hay/feed and feed buckets for the pens. All pens and paddocks have automatic waterers. We are on a 6 gallon per minute water well so any “horse baths” will need to be done with a bucket and sponge, no hosing allowed because of water pressure, or lack thereof...

**Coggins and Health:** Coggins and health are required for horses coming to Bridle Bit. We may be making some trips into Wyoming to move pairs which will require Coggins and health also. If we do make a trip north to work pairs we will trailer pool as best we can.

**Dogs:** We prefer you don’t bring your dogs (ours are ancient and don’t do well with others). But if you have to bring them along please keep them with you at all times.
