Horse Immersion Experiences are designed to offer a unique opportunity to immerse yourself into a horse operation. Our goal is to help you learn what you want and need to know about caring for horses and develop good horsemanship skills. We limit these experiences to a maximum of 2 participants. Our focus is on spending one-on-one time with you to make sure you leave with the information that applies specifically to your situation.

You will have the opportunity to stay with us on our beautiful Colorado ranch. The ranch sits near the foothills north of Fort Collins with easy access to Denver International Airport, Cheyenne Wyoming Airport, Fort Collins/Loveland Airport, Interstate 25, and Interstate 80. Lodging and meals will be provided here at the ranch, but if you need a night out on the town, both Fort Collins, CO and Cheyenne, WY are just 30 minutes away.

You may bring your own horse or use one of ours. If you need to use one of our horses we will provide the gear (saddle and all the other tack) also. We will provide a stall with a run if you bring your own horse. Please bring your hay/grain and any additional items your horse may require during its stay.

Each day you are our guest, we will immerse you in the areas of a horse operation that are important to you. Select from our list of:

- Health
- Farrier/Hoof Health
- Veterinary Care/Horse Health

Our goal is to help you develop a skill set and understanding of horses and horse operations. The time you spend with us will be hands-on, get-it-done, on-the-job learning. We want you to understand the “why” of what we do so that you can make good decisions about your place and your horses when you get back home. We promise that there will be no cookie-cutter approach to working with you. Each day will be customized and tailored to meet your needs and, we will spend whatever time it takes to make sure your comfort level is high in each area we focus on together.

July 15-19 – Arrival date is July 14 and departure date is July 20

September 16-20 – Arrival date is September 15 and departure date is September 21

Time: Friday before the immersion begins is the scheduled arrival date. Please let us know in advance if you need us to pick you up at an airport. If you are driving and bringing your horse, please arrive before dark so we have time to get you and your horse settled in. Every day begins with chores and pen cleaning, then we get to work on your wish list of things you would like to know and work on.

Meals: Meals are provided. Please list any and all food allergies or dislikes so we can plan accordingly.

Housing. Housing for you is provided. A stall with a full with shavings will be provided if you bring your own horse. Please bring your own feed.

Coggins and Health: Coggins and health are required on your horse coming to Bridle Bit. We may be making some trips into Wyoming to move cattle which will require Coggins and health also.

Dogs: No dogs allowed (ours are old and cranky and don't play well with others).

Be sure to bring a "wish list" of things you would like to know regarding all it takes to own and take care of a horse and develop good common sense horsemanship skills.
